GUWAHATI – BHALUKPONG (330 kms/6 hrs)

Guest received at Guwahati from Airport/ Railway Station. Visit Balaji Temple & Drive to Bhalukpong via Tezpur. On the way have traditional foods/coconut water/pure dahi local made/handloom items etc at Thekeraguri Gate at Nagaon. Local Sightseeing's in Tezpur like Agnigarh/Cole park-boating. Night Stay in Bhalukpong.



BHALUKPONG – DIRANG (43 kms/2 hrs)

Morning drive long to Dirang. Natural Beauties like water falls on the Way to Dirang-Tippi On the banks of the river Bharali at an elevation of 190 mtrs is Tipi. Night Stay in Dirang.



DIRANG – TAWANG (195 kms/5 hrs)

Morning Long Drive to Tawang "Switzerland of The East". On the way visit war cemetery. Continue with the drive till you reach Sela Pass at an altitude of 4114m / 13494 ft. It is famous for high altitude lakes & scenic beauty & is ideal for ice skating. Night Stay in the Twang.





TAWANG LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

Early Tawang sightseeings. Tawang Monastery, Namgye Lhaste, PT Tso, Gorsham Chorten, Gontse Garden, Singar Ani Gompa & Maduri Lake. After Sight seen have a walk for local marketing. Night stay in Tawang.



TAWANG – BOMDILA (235 kms/6 hrs)

Early Morning drive to Bomdila. Local sightseeings. Bomdila offers wonderfully panoramic view of Himalayan landscapes and snow clad ranges. Gontse Rabgyaling Monastery (Upper Gonpa), Thub-Chog Gatsel Ling Monastery (Lower Gonpa), Bomdila View Point. Evening you can visit the local market. Overnight stay in Bomdila



BOMDILA – NAMERI (122 kms/4 hrs)

Early Morning long drive back to Nameri. Enroute Sightseeing. Nameri National Park is located in the foothills of the Eastern Himalayas in the Sonitpur





BOMDILA – NAMERI

(122 KMS/4 HRS) CONTINUES...

- District of Assam, India, about 40 kilometres from Tezpur and the third national park in Assam. The Pakhui (Pakke) Sanctuary of Arunachal Pradesh adjoins the Park on its North-Eastern point. Together they constitute an area of over 1000 km² of semi-evergreen, moist deciduous forests with cane and bamboo brakes and narrow strips of open grassland along rivers. Nameri is a birder's paradise with over 300 species of birds.
- Evening leisure & night stay in Nameri.



NAMERI – GUWAHATI

(215 kms/5 hrs)

- Early morning at about 05.30 a.m, set to explore the park on foot (3.2kms), after the trek, back to the room. Having breakfast go for an exclusive rafting (mild rapids) trip on Jia – Boreli River, flowing along the National Park, for water birds. Return back to the room and drive back to Guwahati.
- Evening leisure & Evening River Cruise on Alfresco at The River Brahmaputra at Guwahati and night stay in Guwahati.





GUWAHATI – KAMAKHYA DEPARTURE

Early Morning visit to Maa Kamakhya Temple which is an ancient seat of tantric and shakti cults of Hinduism and considered the most important shrine of Assam, Nabagraha Temple a place considered for a great centre for the study of Astrology and Astronomy in the past and Finally Drop at Airport / Railway Station for Departure.
